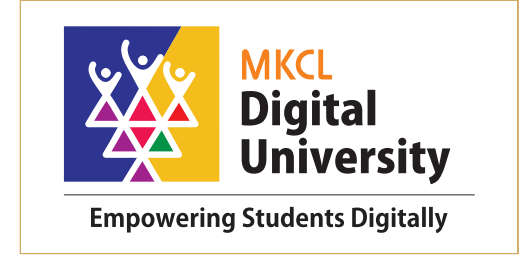

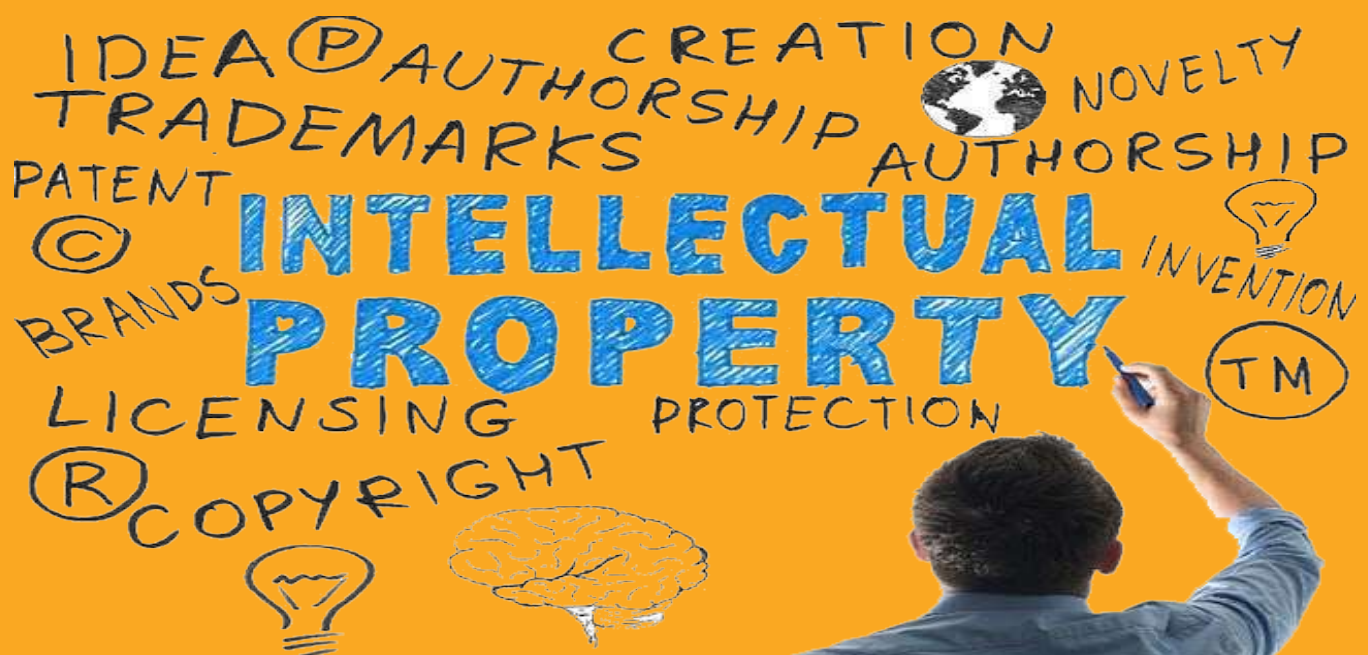

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Program Summary

A DST-GUJCOST sponsored two days National e-Workshop on "Intellectual Property Rights and Patenting" was organized by Tolani Commerce College, Adipur, Kachchh in collaboration with L. M. College of Pharmacy, Ahmedabad, during 13th and 14th August, 2021.

During these two days, there were seven sessions on different topics by experts from Industry and Academia. The Inaugural function was graced by Prof. A. H. Kalro (Academic Advisor, Ahmedabad Education Society, Ahmedabad, Gujarat) as the Chief Guest and Mr. PadminBuch (IPR expert and senior visiting faculty, EDII, Ahmedabad, Gujarat) as the Guest of Honor. The talks by these visionaries highlighted the appropriateness and timing of the national workshop. Prof. Kalro stressed the need for academic institutions to play a major role in the IPR domain. Mr. PadminBuch stressed the filing and commercialization of patents by academic research institutions.

Session - 1 was conducted by Mr. PadminBuch on the topic IPR - An Overview. He started his session with an over view of IPR including information regarding the patent system in India and IPR rights. He also gave live examples regarding trademarks, copyrights, design, geographical indication and many more.

Session - 2 on the Indian and International Patent System was conducted by Dr. Rajeshkumar Acharya. He focused on the Indian and International patent systems. He also emphasized in detail about the filling of patents as per Indian and International system as well as benefits of International filling.

Session - 3 was delivered by Mr. Nagesh Nanda on the topic of Patent Drafting. He covered the various types of patent applications, different types of claims and how to draft a claim which is heart of any patent. He also mentioned the importance of patent claims and key points to be considered during drafting of claim.

Session - 4 on Commercialization of Patent was conducted by Dr. H. Purushotham. He made the audience aware of the step leading to patent commercialization and routes for the commercialization of patents. He also discussed, so many patents are granted, but why only a few are commercialized. He also threw light on the key issues in technology commercialization and licensing agreements and challenges in IP commercialization from R and D labs. Over and above, he mentioned the critical success factors for technology commercialization and the importance of IP protection in start-ups and MSMEs. At last, he also shared few success stories of technology developed and commercialized by NRDC, New Delhi.

Session - 5 on Trademark, Copyright and Design registration in India was conducted by Mr. Abraham. He discussed how and where to registered trademark, copyright and design in

adia along with its renewal duration and process. He has not only answered the questions of participants, but also he asked questions himself to the attendees making the session more interesting for the participants. He also gave examples of live cases connected to the topics, which was the best part of the session.

Session - 6 on Government Initiative to promote IPR was delivered by Dr. PrafulBharadia. He started with the areas for the generation of IPR. He also detailed the different schemes and policies like NISP, SSIP, National IPR policy, Incubation centre and such other government initiative to promote IPR. He also mentioned the role and responsibility of faculty members, guides, mentors as well as institutions in generation of IP and filing of the patent. Sir also explained various granting schemes for MSMEs and eligibility criteria for the same.

Session - 7 by Mr. Amit Patel on Patent Search using Various Databases. He started his lecture by explaining the difference between a research paper and patent, do and don'ts before filing a patent, how to search patents, various paid and free databases available for patent search and live demonstration on how to do a patent search using various databases. He also explained about the patent search operators and gave a piece of detailed information regarding the IPC. The live demo of the patent search and the information about how to select the keywords was amazing. Truly, it was very interesting information and demonstrative session for all the participants.

Dr. Poonam Bhargava (Principal Scientific Officer at Gujarat Council on Science and Technology (GUJCOST), Gandhinagar, Gujarat) as the Chief Guest graced the Valedictory function. Dr. Poonam brilliantly explained various aspects, needs, and importance of IPR. She also informed about the various Government schemes to promote IPR as well as various outreach activities for promotion of science and technology in the state.

The workshop was well attended by 196 participants from all over the country.
